



Our team prepares for shows by practicing multiple nights a week. While putting on ski shows and performing our tricks we do under the Sanction of the US Water Ski Association.


We also give back to our community in big ways:

We are a 5013c non profit ski team that relies on our sponsors to host our **FREE** show, host learn to ski events and host 4th of July Tega Cay Windjammer event.


























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
MISTY GRANT

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
WINTER BARRINGTON-HUGHES

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ABOUT OUR TEAM





Show Acts DEFINITIONS

Barefoot Line: A barefoot line is a great way to open the show. A barefoot line consist of several people next to each other on their bare feet going about 38 MPH. This act gets your blood pumping and opens the show with excitement.

Pyramid: Opening pyramid is a group act in which our team works shows! Each girl comes off the dock on her bases shoulders. We use our balance and strength to climb up with the help of our ropes to perform the opening pyramid!

Shoe Skis: These skiers are on small skis with no fins. This allows them to do quick turns at a faster speed.

Swivel: Swivel is typically performed by the girls on the team. The act is full of grace and poise. The binding on the ski allows them to make 180-degree turns or 360-degree spins.

Trios: Two bases are assigned to one girl. The two bases are on two skis and have a strap around their waists. The strap attaches to the rope, allowing them to have their hands free. They can now use both hands to lift the girl in the air to do multiple tricks.

Doubles: This is a partner act. Sometimes the base is holding the rope and sometimes he has a strap, similar to trios. The base takes his partner off the dock on his shoulders while they do maneuvers without assistance.

Toe Turn Line: This is one of the oldest tricks in the book! Picture perfect! The girls are on swivel skis and their bindings turn 180-degrees. They will brace to each other while their foot is attached to the rope (toe hold) and all turn backwards. Difficult and amazing!

ATB: Keep an eye on the show skiers as the driver takes them 360° all the way around the boat! It's a coordinated dance on skies between the driver and the skier.

Hydrofoil: The Sky Ski rides on a hydrofoil below the water, but lifts the rider out of the water on a chair! These gives the rider complete control to do amazing jumps and flips out of the water!

LEARN TO SKI

Whether you're learning to ski for the first time ever or getting back on the water for the first time in years, our skilled instructors will guide you through a morning of fun on the water. There is no age limit to participate; however, the desire by the participant to learn the sport is important for his/her success.

Participants will have the opportunity to learn to ski on two skis. Those who are successful on two skis can try a single slalom ski. Our instructors WILL have you up on skis within your selected session.

For only \$50 per skier per session, you'll enjoy personalized instruction in a small group setting. Our clinics are sanctioned by USA Water Ski. You'll learn from some of the Carolina Show Ski Team's most talented skiers alongside our certified boat drivers.

Due to high demand, we're adding an additional clinic this summer. Make your reservation early as space is limited. Each day offers an early and late morning session.

Every Friday in July and August they get to show off their newly learned skills at our SKiPs pre show at 6:30pm!













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
